- Ensure the cultural competency and safety training aligns with the cultural safety criteria set by the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners National Faculty of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Health; and
- Deliver a minimum of 12 training sessions in total across the Northern, Western and Southern regions of metropolitan Adelaide.
