Basic Life Support

This 3 hour session will enable participants to maintain their annual competency in this area and will include an overview of the current Australian Resuscitation Council Guidelines.

This session will allow participants the opportunity to review and practice the principles of basic life support including the use of an automated external defibrillator.

Hazardous Manual Tasks (formerly known as Manual Handling)
