

Welcome to Confluence!

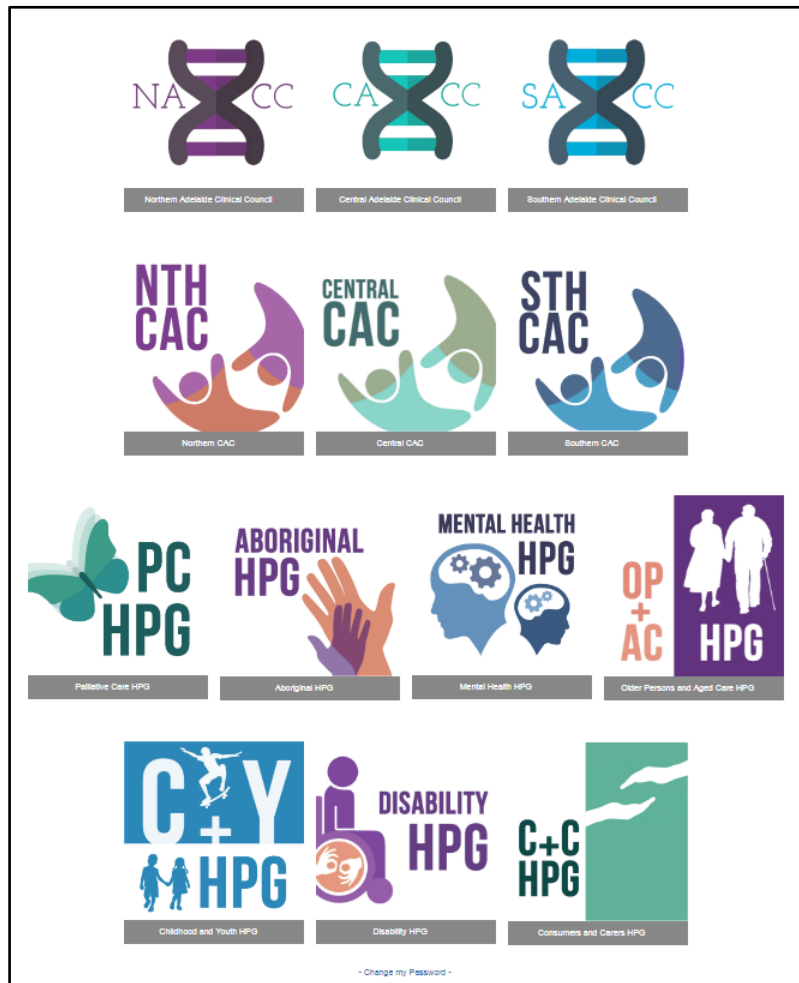
Confluence is an online platform that enables Adelaide PHN to discuss and plan with membership groups, as well as providing a space for members to connect and work together.

How to access your group's confluence page:

1. Go to the confluence website: <https://confluence.adelaidephn.com.au/> OR access via Adelaide PHN's Website www.adelaidephn.com.au Collaborate With Us > Membership > Membership Login
2. Sign in using your provided username (first initial and last name) and password
3. Click through the Confluence video, which will appear on your first login.
4. You will see the main confluence page, click on **MEMBER LOGIN**. Do NOT use the navy-blue navigation bar at the top of the screen.

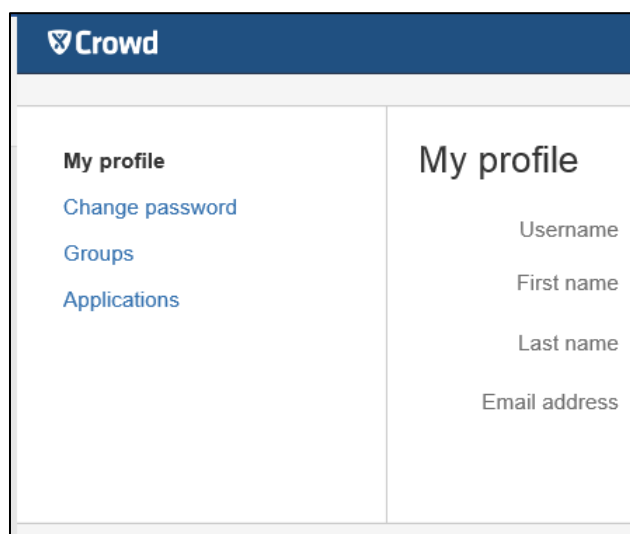

6. On your first login, it's a good idea to change your password to something you will remember. Click on '**Change My password**' at the bottom of the membership navigation page.

Follow the prompt in the new window browser, on the left navigation panel, to change your password:




Your password should be at least 8 characters in length and must contain at least two of the following characters: alpha (letters), numeric(numbers), and special characters (symbols).

Once this is done you can return to the membership login page, in your original browser.

7. Access your groups page by clicking on the relevant button on the navigation page.


You will only be able to access pages for the groups that you are a member of.
