



Free Education Sessions Advance Care Directives Do you really know what your patient wants?



Health professionals and aged care workers aim to provide care that is patient-centred and delivered in line with a person's goals, beliefs and preferences, particularly as people age and become more likely to have multiple chronic conditions.
