



INTERPERSONAL PSYCHOTHERAPY (IPT) TRAINING

27-28 NOVEMBER 2017, ADELAIDE, SOUTH AUSTRALIA

Internationally acclaimed interpersonal psychotherapy (IPT) expert **Professor Scott Stuart** from the University of Iowa (USA) will be visiting Australia in November 2017 and offer a 2-day introductory workshop on IPT in Adelaide.

This short course comes with **IPT Level A Certification** and is open to any health care practitioners with an interest in psychotherapy or counselling, and strongly recommended for all mental health clinicians as well as those in primary care providing brief counselling. Participants will be equipped to conduct IPT at the end of the course. Students and practitioners in training as well as experienced clinicians are welcome.

IPT is an empirically validated treatment for a variety of psychiatric disorders. The evidence for IPT supports its use in primary care for a variety of affective disorders, anxiety disorders, and eating disorders, and for a wide range of patients from children and adolescents to the elderly.

During the 2-day training, you will learn how to construct an interpersonal inventory and formulation, an interpersonal timeline and an interpersonal conflict graph. You will also learn how to apply specific IPT techniques in therapy and provide continuing maintenance treatment.

At the conclusion of the 2-day training, you will be given a workshop post-test to complete. Participants who complete the post-test will receive IPT Level A certification from the Interpersonal Psychotherapy Institute (USA).
