

Quick Guide for Booking your COVID-19 Vaccine

Adelaide PHN continues to play a key role in the South Australian response to COVID-19 and is supporting the phase 1b COVID-19 vaccine roll-out through eligible general practices across the region.

The most vulnerable in our community will be vaccinated first, but everyone in Australia will be offered a safe and effective COVID-19 vaccine. Community members can check if they're eligible, find a vaccination clinic and book an appointment online or over the phone following the four steps provided.

**Note - Not all general practices are providing COVID-19 vaccinations. Eligible vaccination clinics will vaccinate those who do not attend their clinic for health care. The supply of vaccine doses varies across the eligible clinics so appointments may vary. As the vaccine allocation expands, additional appointments will become available. GP-led Respiratory Clinics will generally have more appointments available. You can book by following the steps provided or by visiting adelaidephn.com.au/respiratoryclinics.*



Step 1

Access the COVID-19 Vaccine Eligibility Checker via covid-vaccine.healthdirect.gov.au/eligibility



Step 2

Check your eligibility by clicking 'start' and follow the prompts



Step 3

If eligible, click the 'make a booking' option and enter your location



Step 4

Select a clinic and make your appointment with the details provided (online or over the phone)
