⁽¹⁾ Smoking during pregnancy: In 2013, one in seven (14.5%) women who gave birth in South Australia reported being smokers at their first antenatal visit (the national average was 11.7%). For Aboriginal women, the smoking rate was 51.5% while it was 13.1% for non-Aboriginal women (Source: State of Our Health, 2016, Health Performance Council, viewed at: http://hpcsa.com.au/state_of_our_health/chapter_2/2_4#X-201506101120122, dated 17/06/16).

⁽²⁾ In 2012-13, 40.3% of Aboriginal people in South Australia, aged 15 years or more reported being a current daily smoker (the national average was 41.6%) (Source: State of Our Health, 2016, Health Performance Council, viewed at: http://hpcsa.com.au/state_of_our_health/chapter_3/3_12#X-201509151211135, dated 17/06/16).

⁽³⁾ In 2012-13, approximately one in five (20.5%) Aboriginal people in South Australia aged 15 years or more who reported exceeding lifetime risk guidelines (2009 NHMRC guidelines) for alcohol consumption was above the national average for Aboriginal people of 18.0% (Source: State of Our Health, 2016, Health Performance Council, viewed at: http://hpcsa.com.au/state_of_our_health/chapter_3/3_8#X-201509011705458, dated 17/06/16).

⁽⁴⁾ In 2012-13, 62.9% of Aboriginal people in South Australia aged 15 years and older had a BMI classified as overweight or obese. South Australia's overweight/obesity rate among Aboriginal people is below the national average for Aboriginal people (65.6%) (Source: State of Our Health, 2016, Health Performance Council, viewed at: http://hpcsa.com.au/state_of_our_health/chapter_3/3_9#X-201509021620235, dated 17/06/16).
