Adelaide PHN's Primary Health Care Awards are designed to celebrate outstanding achievement in improving the health and wellbeing of our community across the Adelaide metropolitan region.

The awards can be for a individuals, a partnership, or a team.

This year, Adelaide PHN is looking to recognise the hard work and dedication of primary health care organisations across the Adelaide PHN region, that have been responsive to our community's needs in an ever-changing environment.

## Award Categories and Prizes

- **Outstanding Achievement in Primary Mental Health Care**
- **Outstanding Achievement in Primary Alcohol and Other Drug Treatment Services**
- **Outstanding Achievement in Aboriginal Health**
- **Outstanding Achievement in Aged Care**
- **Outstanding Achievement in Digital Health and General Practice**
- **Outstanding Achievement in Workforce Support**
- **Outstanding Achievement in Population Health / COVID-19 Response**

Each category will be awarded an Outstanding Achievement Award and a Recognition Award.

Outstanding Achievement: is awarded a professional development sponsorship to the value of \$3,000, trophy, framed certificate, and picture and article in our November Connect newsletter.

Recognition award: is awarded a professional development sponsorship to the value of \$1,500, trophy, framed certificate, and picture and article in our November Connect newsletter.

All finalists will receive a certificate of participation.

## Award Categories and Assessment Criteria

Our award categories this year represent Adelaide PHN's national priority areas. Providers may submit an application for multiple award categories but can only win an award in one category per application.

### Award categories

- **Outstanding Achievement in Primary Mental Health Care**  
*Build a person centered, collaborative and integrated primary mental health care system that improves access and outcomes and reduces inequity.*
- **Outstanding Achievement in Primary Alcohol and Other Drug Treatment Services**  
*Build a person centered, collaborative and integrated AOD system that improves access and outcomes and reduces inequity.*
- **Outstanding Achievement in Aboriginal Health**  
*Work together to address health and inequities for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people and increase access to culturally appropriate services.*
- **Outstanding Achievement in Aged Care**  
*Facilitate and establish person centered services that enable and empower older people with the involvement of their families and carers to live well and independently in our community / residential aged care.*
- **Outstanding Achievement in Digital Health and General Practice**  
*Use digital health to enable coordinated care and better-informed treatment decisions in General Practice.*
- **Outstanding Achievement in Workforce Support**  
*Develop and sustain our primary health care workforce in a professional, high quality, safe and inclusive environment.*
- **Outstanding Achievement in Population Health / COVID-19 Response**  
*Understand and improve the health outcomes for population groups or specific population health issues / COVID-19 response.*

## **Assessment criteria**

Each application will be assessed according to its impact upon one or more of the four components of the Quadruple Aim of Primary Health Care. Please provide evidence for as many components as possible.

- *Improved Patient Experience:* Better care (safe, quality care); timely and equitable access; Patient and family needs met.
- *Improved Provider Experience:* Increased clinician and staff satisfaction; leadership and teamwork; quality improvement culture in practice.
- *Advancing Population Health:* Better health outcomes; reduced disease burden; improvement in physical and mental health.
- *Sustainable Cost:* Efficient and effective services; increased resources for primary care; commissioning effectively.

## **Terms and Conditions**

### ***Eligibility***

Awards are open to all current Adelaide PHN commissioned service providers, Adelaide PHN partnership and general practice activities or those that are part of Adelaide PHN councils' activities.

The achievements described in the nomination must have been delivered within the Adelaide PHN region, be current and have taken place, or been developed in, the last financial year (between **1 July 2021 and 30 June 2022**).

### ***Entry Process***

Completed entries via the [Nomination Form](#) must be received by **close of business Wednesday 5 October 2022**. Entries received after this time will not be considered for the awards and no responsibility will be accepted by Adelaide PHN for lost, late, incomplete, or incorrectly submitted entries.

Nominees will need to select which category they are applying for on the application form. More than one category can be selected per organisation, however only one nomination per activity will be accepted.

Word limits must be strictly adhered to.

Self-nominations are acceptable.

Nominations on behalf of groups, partnerships or organisations should elect a main contact to be responsible for receiving and administering award funds.

Only completed entries will be accepted.

### ***Judging and Selection***

Adelaide PHN will convene an internal judging panel to assess all entries.

The judging panel's assessment will be based on the evidence submitted against the assessment criteria.

The judging panel may contact applicants for further information if necessary.

All decisions are final, and no correspondence shall be entered into.

Award recipients of each category will be contacted week commencing 10 October 2022 to ensure they are attending the dinner or have a representative attending.

Throughout the judging process, all information that has been supplied and submitted for entry into the awards will be kept strictly confidential and will only be disclosed to the judging panel and appropriate employees of Adelaide PHN.

### ***Awards Ceremony***

Primary Health Care Awards will be announced and presented at our Adelaide PHN Annual Primary Health Care Awards Dinner on Saturday 22 October 2022.

### ***Obligations***

All award recipients are required to provide a tax invoice for the sponsorship to Adelaide PHN by no later than 30 June 2023 via their Adelaide PHN Capacity Building Coordinator or Practice Facilitator.

All award recipients are required to provide Adelaide PHN with a summary, images of the activity, and learnings that resulted from these sponsorship awards.

All award recipients agree to their names and images appearing in Adelaide PHN publications and social media.
