Adelaide PHN aims to better understand the health needs of our region and determine priorities. This report card shows how key PHN Performance Indicators relating to population health are tracking in the Adelaide PHN region in 2019/2020.

Immunisation

Our Champion Nurse Immunisation Program provided **754 episodes of support** to community and immunisation providers

93.9% Children fully immunised at 5 years old

94.7% Aboriginal children fully immunised at 5 years old

Children and Youth

Our Paediatric Partnership Project provided timely access to assessments for children on existing public waitlists by supporting...



Culturally and Linguistically Diverse

Our Adelaide Refugee and New Arrivals Program provided **593 registered nurse supports** to 215 clients and **399 health literacy sessions** to 113 clients

✓ **Outcome** increased access to services for vulnerable communities
