Adelaide PHN aims to develop and sustain those working in the primary health care sector across our region. This report card shows how key PHN Performance Indicators relating to health workforce are tracking in the Adelaide PHN region in 2019/2020.

Accreditation

We held **3 AGPAL Workshops** on the 5th Accreditation Standards for General Practice with **55 attendees**

83% of practices in our region have achieved accreditation

COVID-19 Response

Supported establishment of 4 Respiratory Clinics, contributing to the **151,285 COVID-19 tests** undertaken in SA

Supported 2,250 direct COVID-19 enquiries and dispatched over **150,000 pieces of PPE**



Capacity Building
