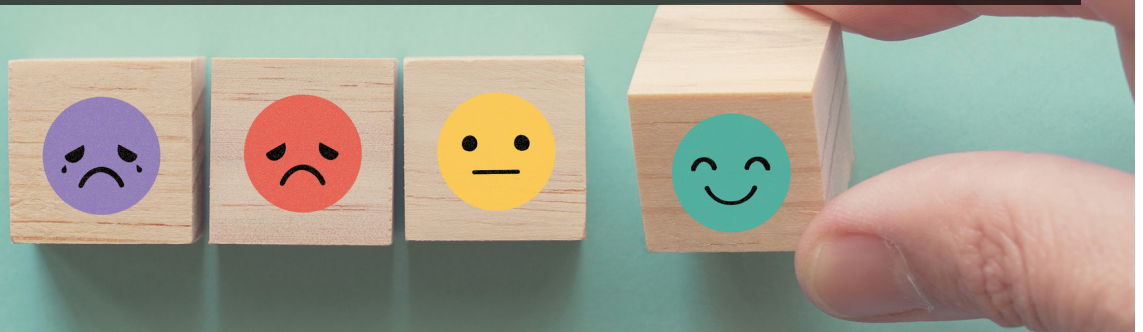


Funded Mental Health First Aid Training - new training sessions now available



FREE mental health first aid training for SA community pharmacists and pharmacy staff

Normally valued at \$360 for PSA members and \$505 for non-members!

About the program

The South Australian Government, through the Office of the Chief Pharmacist, is funding mental health first aid (MHFA) training to upskill community pharmacists and pharmacy staff working in South Australia to improve early identification of mental ill-health and increase mental health support for the community.

The Pharmaceutical Society of Australia has been commissioned by the South Australian Government to deliver MHFA training to at least 1000 community pharmacists and pharmacy staff working across metropolitan and regional South Australia between 2023 and 2026.

24 Group 2 CPD points are available for pharmacists upon completion of the training.

Who can participate?

Community pharmacists and all pharmacy staff (e.g. dispensary technicians, pharmacy assistants and intern pharmacists) who are employed and work in South Australian community pharmacies are eligible for the funded training.
