



Support to identify and respond to people experiencing eating disorders, disordered eating and body image concerns within Adelaide PHN

The Right Care Right Place (RCRP) project aims to improve access to and coordination of eating disorder care within Adelaide PHN by training and supporting the local workforce, building referral networks and supporting health professionals and people experiencing eating disorders through a local Service Navigator.

Health professionals who sign up to RCRP receive the following:

Free professional development

You will gain access to free training and resources tailored to your role and PD needs

Referrals

You can be added to a referral database of local providers for people experiencing suspected eating disorders

RCRP Newsletter

Regular newsletters overviewing local events, service offerings, PD opportunities and updates on eating disorders evidence-based practice

RCRP Service Navigator (Eating Disorders) and Project Lead Support

Ongoing contact and support from your local PHN and Eating Disorder Coordinator

Outcome-informed treatment tools

Including access to an ED-15 questionnaire with automated scoring for clients/patients, streamlining the assessment process
